#### Some great startups born in the Weekends:



- Zapier (USA) During a Weekend in Columbia, Missouri, the Zapier team developed the idea of connecting different applications and services without the need for coding. Today, Zapier is an essential automation tool with millions of users and a billion-dollar valuation.
- Uniplaces (Portugal) An online housing platform for university students. Uniplaces was born in 2011 at a Startup Weekend and, by 2016, it was generating over one million euros per week in rentals. Its founders were featured in the Forbes 30 Under 30 list in 2017.



## The Startup Weekend is a three-day event that brings together entrepreneurs, developers, designers, and specialists from various fields to collaborate on startup creation projects.

- During the event, participants have the chance to turn their ideas into prototypes, learn new skills, and connect with other entrepreneurs;
- They also gain access to experienced mentors and guest speakers who share their knowledge and experiences;
- In just one weekend, many participants manage to progress from an idea to making their first sales.

The goal of the Startup Weekend is to accelerate the startup creation process by providing a collaborative and highly focused environment to test and validate business ideas in a short timeframe.

## Our Journey in Numbers:



Over 7 months (from October 2024 to May 2025), we pulled off 5 Startup Weekends across 5 Portuguese cities.

- 277 people signed up for TSW196 participated the full 3 days
  - 58 (22%) of registered people where foreign, and some of them came to Portugal specifically for the Weekend.
- We had **7 free pre-Weekend workshops** that brought in **320** registrations and **195** attendees.

- 470+ people in total at all our events\*
   19 different nationalities
   38 startups were born
   63 mentors and judges got involved
- 56 partners and sponsors backed us 20+ articles published in media and press
- 700+ people mobilized across all our initiatives

Last Friday, we took the Santa Luzia funicular in Viana do Castelo for an elevator pitch as part of Viana Tech Day.

Since the idea for Padel AI began to take shape, we haven't stopped presenting it and bringing together the right people and resources to make it happen. The concept has been validated, and now the implementation phase is underway. The focus is on turning this idea into reality within a few weeks, with the development of an MVP that will enable initial testing in select clubs, already identified, that are eager to try a new way of analyzing and improving performance in Padel.













### Lisbon

**#StartupWeekend** Coimbra is in the rearview mirror and I wanted to share one of the highlights that epitomizes the magic of SW for me:

A 19-yr old female student named Maria from the Polytechnic university shows up Friday night with no intention to pitch but is passionate about female reproductive health and hormones. She ends up pitching and rallying a team. Her team goes into the field to do interviews and find there's no demand for the hormonal health app she had envisioned but via a conversation orchestrated by one of the mentors they gain a key insight, adapt the idea and by Sunday night have landed a government partnership to provide a menopause education program to women of Coimbra . And then she wins a full scholarship to the Founders Institute to get ongoing support. The video here is her receiving that scholarship award.

This past weekend is what I call a "crossroad moment" - one of those impossible-to-foresee detours in the road that almost certainly changes the trajectory this young woman's life bringing her onto the path of entrepreneurship. There were a million other little moments, connections, hugs, challenges & epiphanies, stressors & breakthroughs for the attendees this weekend. From 19yrs to ~65, we had people from all over - Pakistan, Brazil, Colombia, US, UK, Finland, Hungary, India and a dozen other countries ... this is the way.

I was fortunate to attend the very first Startup Weekend hosted by **Andrew Hyde** in San Francisco almost 20yrs ago and I contest this remains the single most effective way to onboard people of any age into the world of startups and entrepreneurship. This is why we do these events: to introduce people to what I believe is the greatest lever to move the world.




